You can choose from a variety of opportunities to make a difference in a child's life.

(The life that's changed may be your own!)

- TUTORS - Help a child become a successful reader. Work on helping a student learn his/her sounds and strategies for figuring out new words they encounter when reading. Training available. (1 or more hrs. per wk., during or after school)
- LIBRARY ASSISTANCE - Help with cataloging books, checking books out to students, reading to the children. (1 or more hrs. per wk.)
- TEACHER APPRECIATION - Put a little wind in the sails of teachers and staff by providing periodic luncheons, snacks, gift bags. (flexible time commitment)
- FINANCIAL LITERACY PROGRAM - Help students learn basics of banking, budgeting, checking & savings accounts. (commitment: 4 hrs. of teaching - dates & times are flexible; training required.)
- FOOD BAGGING - Volunteers are needed every Wednesday during the school year to prepare food bags. These bags for "at risk" children are assembled at the Alameda County Food Bank located just off HWY 880 near the Oakland Stadium at: 7900 Edgewater Drive, Oakland. (1 day per wk., Wednesdays between 10am - noon)
- WRITING COACH - Volunteer coaches provide approximately an hour or two a week helping students become confident writers and critical thinkers.
- CAMPUS BEAUTIFICATION - Help with school gardens, bulletin boards, campus clean-up days, mural projects, etc. (flexible time commitment)
- PLAYGROUND MONITOR - Build relationships with kids, help ensure campus safety, respect for self and others. (1 hr. per wk., before school or during lunchtime recess - "Lunch Buddy")
- CLASSROOM ASSISTANT - Provide support to the teacher in the classroom by completing general tasks, including working with students at times. (1 or more hrs. per wk.)
